

2022 LWGA TOURNAMENT SCHEDULE

- The maximum course handicap for LWGA tournament events is 36. Players with a handicap index higher than 34.9 must play to a 34.9 index (a 36 course handicap from yellow tees).
- Ties will be decided by a match of cards unless otherwise specified in the tournament format.

April 5 *LWGA Opening Member Meeting, 6:00 p.m.*

April 5, 12, 19 *Open play. No prizes. Players choose their own tee times.*

April 26 **Opening Day Tournament** – 8:00 a.m. Shotgun and lunch. Best ball scramble. Team event. Mixed flight teams assigned by TC (Tournament Chair) using 50% of the average team handicap.

Event format: Every player hits a drive on every hole. Team decides which drive will be used and everyone hits a ball from that spot (including the player whose drive is used). Follow this format until you get on the green. All players putt until the ball is holed. Each player's drive must be used for 3 holes. Record your team's gross score on the official scorecard. Enter hole by hole gross score in Leaderboard and leave official card in the bin.

Note for 3 player teams: Each of the players will play 2 shots at each position for 6 holes during the round. Agree on the rotation order before starting your round (i.e., who will be Player A, Player B and C) and proceed as follows: Player A hits 2 shots at each position for holes 1-6; Player B hits 2 shots at each position for holes 7-12; Player C hits 2 shots at each position for holes 13-18 .

Prizes: 1st, 2nd and 3rd Low Gross teams, and 1st, 2nd and 3rd Low Net teams.

GHIN, Ringers, Eagles, Birdies and Chip-ins don't count.

May 3 **Trophy Tuesday** – Tee times, no lunch. Stroke Play. Individual effort. Paired in flights by TC.

Prizes: One Low Gross winner and One Low Net winner per flight.

May 9 *SCWGA Tournament – This is not an LWGA event. Contact Lynn Cerrone for details to sign up for this tournament.*

George Buck Tournament - Major tournament extending from May 10-26 – If you sign up, you must be available to play in all rounds. (See dates that follow.) Top 16 lowest net scoring players in the May 10 Qualifying Round move on to match play rounds. **The TC will assign tee times for subsequent rounds of play on these dates: 1st round - May 17 (during Tues. block), 4 foursomes; 2nd round - Thurs., May 19, 2 foursomes; Semifinals - May 24 (during Tues. block) 1 foursome; and Final - Thurs., May 26, 1 twosome. If you make it past the qualifying round, you must be available to play on these dates if you move on - so make sure you clear your calendar before you sign up.** There are no eligibility requirements for this tournament. Paired in flights by TC.

May 10 **George Buck Qualifying Round** – Stroke play. Individual effort. Tee times and pairings by handicap by TC.

Event format: Use 100% of your handicap. Top 16 Lowest Net scoring players qualify for the 1st round of Match Play on May 17. A tie among qualifiers will be broken by a Match of Cards. After the qualifying round, draw sheet will be posted in Leaderboard and updated as each round of play is completed. The winner in each match proceeds to subsequent rounds of play.

GHIN Tournament Type: Competition. **Rain date:** May 17

May 17-May 26 **George Buck Tournament – Round 1, 2, Semi Finals and Final** – Match play. Tee times and pairings by TC.

Event format: Match Play. 100% of player handicap will be used. Stroked scorecards will be provided. Each qualifier must be available to play in each round or will be automatically disqualified. The TC will assign tee times for rounds 1, 2, semifinals and final that may be outside of the scheduled Tuesday tournament. You must be available to play in these assigned times so make sure to clear your calendar. (For GB rounds played during the Tuesday block, May 17 & May 24, GB competitors will not be eligible to compete in the concurrent stroke play event.)

The TC will assign tee times for rounds of play as follows: 1st round - May 17 (during Tues. block), 4 foursomes; 2nd round - Thurs., May 19, 2 foursomes; Semifinals - May 24 (during Tues. block) 1 foursome; and Final - Thurs., May 26, 1 twosome.

Prizes: Low Net winner and Low Net runner-up. (If a match is tied after the 18th hole, to establish a winner, the match is extended one hole at a time until there is a winner, beginning on hole #1.)

GHIN Tournament Type: Competition.

May 17 ***Stroke Play Tournament** – Stroke play. Individual effort. Players choose tee times. Note: this tournament will accommodate players who are not participating in the George Buck 1st round play.

Prizes: 1st, 2nd and 3rd Low Gross and Low net per flight. Rain date for GB Qualifier. **Extended play period:** May 12-16.

May 24 ***Throw Out 3 Tournament** – 8:00 a.m. Shotgun and **lunch**. Stroke play. Individual effort. Players chose tee times.

Event Format: You must play all 18 holes and hole out on every hole for your score to count. Once a player's hole-by-hole score is entered under the tournament, LS will subtract the scores of the player's three worst holes. The resulting score will be the player's score for the tournament. (The actual adjusted 18 hole score will be posted to GHIN by LS.)

Prizes: 1st, 2nd & 3rd place Low Gross and Low Net per flight. **Extended play period:** May 19-23.

May 31 **President's Cup Tournament - Round 1** – Two-day, 36-hole Major Tournament; Two-person team stroke play. Best ball of twosome. Players choose their own two-person teams. (See handicap requirement below.) Tee times assigned by TC.

Event format: This is a Major Tournament consisting of two days of stroke play, best ball of twosome, 36-hole cumulative score. You must satisfy eligibility requirements outlined on Page 2 of the member handbook to qualify for this tournament. Players must be available to play both May 31 and June 7. For each two-person team, there is an 8 stroke maximum difference between the player handicaps; e.g., Player 1 - Handicap 20, Player 2 - Handicap 30; Player 2 - will play to a handicap of 28. 100% of the allowed player course handicaps will be used to determine net best ball score of the team in Leaderboard. Player handicaps in effect for Round 1 will apply for the entire tournament. Stroked scorecards will be provided. Enter Gross score on scorecard. (LS will calculate net scores.) Non-Qualifiers may sign up to play after Qualifiers.

Prizes: First Place Low Gross winner and Runner-Up, and First Place Low Net winner and Runner-Up. (If there is a tie for Low Gross after 36 holes, the two teams proceed to sudden death beginning on hole #1, playing until there is a winner. In the event of a tie for other prizes, winner will be determined by a match of cards.)

GHIN Tournament Type: Competition. **Rain date:** June 7

June 7 **President's Cup Tournament - Round 2** – Two-day 36 hole Major Tournament; Two-person team stroke play. Best ball of twosome. Tee times assigned by TC. See May 31 for description. Non-Qualifiers may sign up to play after Qualifiers. **Rain date:** June 14

June 14 ***Stroke Play Tournament** – Stroke play. Individual effort. Players choose tee times. (See May 17 for details.) Rain date for President's Cup. **Extended play period:** June 9-13.

June 21 **Trophy Tuesday** - 8:00 a.m. Shotgun and **lunch**. Stroke Play. Individual effort. Paired in mixed flights by TC. **Prizes:** One Low Gross winner and One Low Net winner per flight.

June 28 **Play for Pink Tournament** – Stroke play, four-person team event. Players choose tee times. If you don't have a team and you want to play, contact the Tournament Chairs.

Contributions collected for this tournament will benefit the Breast Cancer Emergency Aid Foundation.

Event format: Stroked scorecards will be provided as well as one numbered pink ball per foursome. Alternating use of PINK BALL within team. Player 1 plays PINK BALL on Hole 1; Player 2 plays PINK BALL on Hole 2; Player 3 plays PINK BALL on Hole 3; Player 4 plays PINK BALL on Hole 4; Player 1 plays PINK BALL on Hole 5; and so on. PINK BALL must come back to the clubhouse for team to win. If your team loses the PINK BALL the team is disqualified. Record score of the PINK BALL for the 18 holes and submit one official scorecard. Take your strokes where they fall on the scorecard when it is your turn to play the PINK BALL to figure out Net Score. Record Gross Score and Net Score for PINK BALL for each hole.

Prizes: 1st, 2nd and 3rd Low Gross teams, and 1st, 2nd and 3rd Low Net teams.

GHIN, Ringers, Eagles, Birdies and Chip-ins don't count. **Rain date:** July 5

July 5 **The Stableford** – Stroke play. Individual effort. Players choose tee times.

Event format: Players enter hole-by-hole gross score under the tournament. LS calculates points earned on the net score for each hole, awarding points as follows: 9 pts.-Double Eagle, 7 pts.-Eagle, 5 pts.-Birdie, 3 pts.-Par, 1 pt.-Bogey.

Prizes: 1st and 2nd place for highest point total per flight.

Rain date for Play for Pink.

July 12 **Trophy Tuesday** – 8:00 a.m. Shotgun and **lunch**. Stroke Play. Individual effort. Paired in flights by TC.

Prizes: One Low Gross winner and One Low Net winner per flight.

July 19 Club Championship - Round 1 – Two-Day, 36-Hole Major Tournament. Stroke play. Individual effort. Paired in flights by TC with full handicap.

Event Format: You must satisfy eligibility requirements outlined on Page 2 of the member handbook to qualify for this tournament. Total of two-day cumulative stroke play score. Player handicaps in effect for Round 1 will apply for the entire tournament. Players must be available to play both July 19 and 26. Non-qualifiers may sign up after qualifiers.

Prizes: Overall Low Gross score wins Championship, Second Low Gross wins Runner Up. One Low Net winner for each flight. One Low Gross winner for 2nd, 3rd and 4th flight. (If there is a tie for Overall Low Gross after 36 holes, the players proceed to sudden death beginning on hole #1, playing until there is a winner. In the event of a tie for other prizes, winner will be determined by a match of cards.)

GHIN Tournament Type: Competition. **Rain date:** July 26

July 26 Club Championship - Round 2 – Two-Day, 36-Hole Major Tournament. Stroke play. Individual effort. Paired in flights by TC with full handicap. See July 19 for details. Non-qualifiers may sign up after qualifiers.

Rain date: Aug. 2

Aug 2 *Stroke Play Tournament – Stroke Play. Individual effort. Players choose tee times.

Prizes: 1st, 2nd and 3rd Low Gross and Low net per flight. Rain date for Club Championship.

Extended play period: July 28 - Aug.1.

Aug 4 LWGA Lobster Fest (Will hold member meeting)

Aug. 8 SNEWGA Super Seniors/Legends – This is not an LWGA event. Contact Chris Lorusso for details to sign up for this tournament.

Aug. 9 Trophy Tuesday – Tee times; no lunch. Stroke Play. Individual effort. Paired in mixed flights by TC.

Prizes: One Low Gross winner and One Low Net winner per flight.

Aug. 16 Diamonds vs. Hearts Match Play – Best net ball of twosome, match play. Players choose two-person teams. Full handicap will be used. Foursomes chosen by TC.

Event Format: Each two-person team competes in match play against the other team in the foursome. One team in the foursome is competing under Diamonds and the other under Hearts. Competition is hole by hole, best net ball of each twosome against other twosome's best net ball. Each hole is worth 1 point; ½ point to each team if a hole is tied. Every point matters. Stroked cards will be provided. Each player's gross score is entered on the card. After all scores are in, the team (Diamonds or Hearts) with the highest total points wins.

Prizes: Each person on the winning team (Diamonds or Hearts) wins a prize.

GHIN, Ringers, Eagles, Birdies and Chip-ins don't count.

Aug 23 LWGA Member Guest Tournament – 8:30 a.m. Shotgun followed by lunch. Step Aside Scramble.

Event Format: Member can invite a guest and request foursomes. Carts mandatory. Stroked scorecards will be provided. Everyone in the foursome tees off. The player whose ball is chosen can't hit the next shot. That player "steps aside." The other three players move their balls to the chosen spot and hit from there. This format continues until reaching the putting green. Everyone putts until the ball is holed. Three drives from each player must be used and indicated on the team's scorecard. Submit team score on official scorecard. Each foursome will have an assigned handicap based on 50% of the average of the team's handicaps. This number will be subtracted from the team's total gross for the net score.

Prizes: 1st and 2nd Low Gross teams and 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th Low Net teams.

GHIN, Ringers, Eagles, Birdies and Chip-ins don't count.

Aug. 30 *Stroke Play Tournament – Stroke Play. Individual effort. Players choose tee times.

Prizes: 1st, 2nd and 3rd Low Gross and Low net per flight. **Extended play period:** Aug. 25-29.

Sept 6 Fall Cup - Round 1 – Two day, 36-Hole Major Tournament. Stroke play, individual effort. TC assigns tee times and pairings by flight.

Event Format: You must satisfy eligibility requirements outlined on Page 2 of the member handbook to qualify for this tournament. Players must be available to play both Sept. 6 and 13. Player handicaps in effect for Round 1 will apply for the entire tournament. Total of two-day cumulative stroke play score.

Prizes: awarded for Low Gross and Low Net per flight. **GHIN Tournament Type:** Competition. **Rain date:** Sept. 13

Sept 13 Fall Cup - Round 2 – Two-day, 36-Hole Major Tournament. Stroke Play. Individual effort. TC assigns tee times and pairings by flight. See description September 6. **Rain date:** Sept. 27

Sept 20 Trophy Tuesday – 8:00 a.m. Shotgun and lunch. Stroke Play. Individual effort. Paired in flights by TC.
Prizes: One Low Gross winner and One Low Net winner per flight.

Sept 27 *Stroke Play Tournament – Stroke Play. Individual effort. Players choose tee times
Prizes: 1st, 2nd and 3rd Low Gross and Low net per flight. Rain date for Fall Cup. **Extended play period:** Sept. 22-26.

Oct 4 The Caryl Beatus Member/Member Tournament – 8:00 a.m. Shotgun. Two person team stroke play. Best Net Ball of twosome. Members create their own two-person teams. Players can be from any flight.
Event Format: 18 hole stroke play, best net ball of twosome. Each player plays her own ball. Both players enter gross scores on scorecard. LS will calculate team best net ball score.
Prizes: 1st - 6th Low Net teams

Oct 11 Five Clubs – Stroke Play. Individual effort. Players chose tee times.
Event Format: Each player selects only five clubs for this tournament. Putter counts as a club. Full handicap is used.
Prizes: 1st, 2nd and 3rd Low Gross and Low Net per flight.
GHIN, Ringers, Eagles, Birdies and Chip-ins don't count.

Oct 18 Trophy Tuesday – Tee times; no lunch. Stroke Play. Individual effort. Paired in mixed flights by TC.
Prizes: One Low Gross winner and One Low Net winner per flight.

Oct 25 Closing Day Scramble and Closing Banquet – Best ball Step Aside scramble. Mixed flights paired by TC.
Team event.

Event Format: All players tee off, then the team selects the best drive. Each player drops a ball within one club length of the spot (one putter head on the green) no closer to the hole and in the same condition as the selected ball (i.e., fairway, rough, bunker) and hits a second shot from the spot except the player whose drive was used. (That player 'steps aside') Follow this format until you get on the green. All players get to putt until the ball is holed. Each player's drive must be used for 3 holes.

Scoring: Record team gross score on the scorecard. (Leaderboard will calculate a net score based on 50% of the average handicap.) Note whose drive was used on the appropriate player line for all 18 holes. After the round, post team gross score in Leaderboard, including drives used. Leave official scorecard in the bin.

Note for 3 Player teams: Each of the players will play 2 shots at each position for 6 holes during the round. Agree on the rotation order before starting your round (i.e., who will be Player A, Player B and C) and proceed as follows: Player A hits 2 shots at each position for holes 1-6; Player B hits 2 shots at each position for holes 7-12; Player C hits 2 shots at each position for holes 13-18 .

Prizes: 1st, 2nd and 3rd Low Gross teams, and 1st, 2nd and 3rd Low Net teams.

GHIN, Ringers, Eagles, Birdies and Chip-ins don't count.

*These six designated Extended Play tournaments can be played for prizes from the Thursday before the scheduled tournament up to and including the scheduled tournament time, as long as it is played with another LWGA member and a signed and attested scorecard is left in the women's locker room. This will provide flexibility for our players who work full time or have other commitments that keep them from playing on Tuesday mornings.
